Tasting Notes



The aromas and flavors of berries, chocolate and dark walnuts are pure and to the point here. The palate is chiselled, stretched by an invisible thread, while unfolding a velvety and caressing body, with slightly candied fruit punctuated by spices and a hint of undergrowth. The finish is more concentrated, with a fine subtle texture and hints of plum, blackcurrant and menthol lingering for a long time. It's medium-to-full-bodied with firm, polish tannins that show focus and depth.
